2.GENERAL INFORMATION

A.SERRA CITY:

SERRA IS AN IMPORTANT TOURIST CITY IN BRAZIL. ITS GEOGRAPHICAL POSITION AND LOGISTICS FACILITIES HAVE

MADE IT ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT BUSINESS CENTERS IN THE STATE OF ESPÍRITO SANTO AND ONE OF THE MOST

PROSPEROUS CITIES IN BRAZIL, RANKING 4TH IN GDP AMONG BRAZILIAN MUNICIPALITIES.

FOUNDED AT THE TIME OF THE HEREDITARY CAPTAINCIES, THE CITY IS ONE OF THE CULTURAL CRADLES OF ESPÍRITO

SANTO STATE, OWNER OF A DIVERSIFIED HERITAGE AND A STRIKING IDENTITY. ACCORDING TO THE OLD MASTERS OF POPULAR CULTURE, THE CONGO, THE MAIN MANIFESTATION OF CAPIXABA FOLKLORE, WOULD HAVE ORIGINATED IN

PUTIRI, A RURAL AREA OF THE SERRA.

THE CITY IS ALSO HOME TO JESUIT HERITAGE, HISTORICAL RUINS, SEVERAL ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AREAS AND

SOME OF THE MOST BEAUTIFUL LANDSCAPES IN THE STATE, WITH EXUBERANT NATURE AND PRIVILEGED BY THE

MIXTURE OF SEA, LAKES, MOUNTAINS AND VALLEYS.

N ADDITION. SERRA HOSTS ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT POPULAR AND RELIGIOUS FESTIVALS IN BRAZIL. THE SÃO

BENEDITO FOLKLORIC AND RELIGIOUS CYCLE, WHICH ALWAYS BEGINS ON THE SECOND SUNDAY OF DECEMBER. IT IS

5. ENTRIES BY COUNTRY AND ATHLETES

A. PRE-INSCRIPTION - NUMERICAL: MUST BE DONE BY FILLING OUT THE FORM SENT BY THE ORGANIZATION, WHICH MUST BE RETURNED COMPLETED BEFORE FEBRUARY 04, 2022 TO THE EMAIL ADDRESS LUCIMARA@CBAT.ORG.BR.

B. EACH COUNTRY MAY ENTER UP TO SIX (6) ATHLETES PER EVENT, AND THE PLACEMENT OF THE TOP FOUR TEAM ATHLETES IS ADDED TO THE TEAM'S RESULTS, IN ALL CATEGORIES OF THE CHAMPIONSHIPS.

C.EACH COUNTRY MUST REGISTER THEIR ATHLETES USING THE ONLINE REGISTRATION SITE HTTPS://CBAT.ORG.BR/NOVO/EXTRANET/, SINCE THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE WILL PROVIDE A LOGIN AND PASSWORD FOR EACH COUNTRY, WHICH MUST BE USED. IN THE INSCRIPTIONS.

D. COUNTRIES MUST ENSURE THAT ALL INFORMATION IS COMPLETE AND THAT ATHLETES ENTER THE CORRECT EVENT.

E. THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE WILL SEND AN EMAIL WITH THE CONFIRMATION OF THE INSCRIPTIONS TO EACH COUNTRY.

F.THE PRELIMINARY INSCRIPTION OF THE PARTICIPATING TEAMS WILL TAKE PLACE ONLINE THROUGH THE COMPETITION SYSTEM, FROM FEBRUARY 21 TO 25, 2022 (11:59 P.M. - BRASILIA TIME).

G. THE FINAL INSCRIPTION OF THE PARTICIPATING TEAMS WILL TAKE PLACE FROM MARCH 7 TO 14, 2022 (11:59 P.M. - BRASILIA TIME).

H. EACH COUNTRY WILL RECEIVE A USERNAME AND PASSWORD TO REGISTER IN THE COMPETITION SYSTEM.

- A) BE BORN IN THE COUNTRY WHICH REPRESENTS;
- B) BE NATURALIZED BY THE COUNTRY THAT WHICH WILL REPRESENT;
- C) BE WITHIN THE AGE LIMIT ESTABLISHED FOR THE CATEGORY IN WHICH IS REGISTERED;
- D) BE DULY REGISTERED BY THE COUNTRY'S FEDERATION;
- E) PARTICIPATE IN THE CONTEST OF YOUR FEDERATION.

8. TRANPORTATION

THE INTERNAL TRANSPORTATION OF THE DELEGATIONS WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE.

AIRPORT/HOTEL TRANSPORTATION WILL BE CARRIED OUT ACCORDING TO THE ARRIVALS OF THE FLIGHTS INFORMED BY THE DELEGATIONS IN THE FINAL REGISTRATION; IN THE SAME WAY THE HOTEL/AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION TO THE END OF THE EVENT.

9. AIRPORT

10. ACCREDITATION

A. THE ACCREDITATION AND THE CIT WILL BE LOCATED IN THE OFFICIAL HOTELS OF THE EVENT AND WILL BE OPEN:

- FRIDAY MARCH 25 FROM 8:00 AM TO 7:00 PM
- SATURDAY MARCH 26 FROM 8:00 AM TO 4:00 PM

B. TEAM LEADERS MUST BRING SAMPLES OF THE NATIONAL TEAM UNIFORM AND ATHLETES' PASSPORTS TO VERIFY THE AGES OF ALL COMPETITORS.

11. UNIFORMS AND AWARD CEREMONY

- A. PARTICIPATING ATHLETES MUST WEAR THE OFFICIAL UNIFORM OF THEIR SELECTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH WA RULES;
- B. THE AWARD CEREMONY WILL TAKE PLACE ACCORDING TO THE TIMETABLE. ATHLETES, WHEN CALLED, MUST WEAR THE OFFICIAL UNIFORM OF THEIR NATIONAL TEAM.
- C. SEPARATE CEREMONIES WILL BE HELD FOR THE PAN AMERICAN AND SOUTH AMERICAN CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS.
- D. ALL PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES MUST DELIVER 2 NATIONAL FLAGS (0.90X1.38CM) TO THE ORGANIZATION UPON ARRIVAL FOR THE AWARD CEREMONIES.

12. MEDICAL ASSISTANCE - MEDICAL AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE

- A. DURING THE CHAMPIONSHIPS THERE WILL BE SPACE AVAILABLE FOR THE TEAMS TO INSTALL THEIR PHYSIOTHERAPY IN THE WARM-UP AREA.
- B. THE COMPETITION VENUE WILL BE STAFFED BY AN EVENT DOCTOR AND FIRST AID MEDICAL PERSONNEL. THE FIRST AID TEAM WILL HAVE 2 STATIONS ADJACENT TO THE CIRCUIT (START / FINISH AND IKM POINT). THE INDIVIDUAL FIRST AID RESPONSE WILL BE AVAILABLE ON SITE AND IN RADIO COMMUNICATION WITH THE MEMBERS OF THE ORGANIZATION.
- C. THE MEDICAL SERVICE IS FREE; HOWEVER, IT WILL BE THE PARTICIPANT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO PAY FOR ANY ADDITIONAL SPECIALIZED SERVICES, INCLUDING EMERGENCY ROOM, CONSULTATION WITH A MEDICAL SPECIALIST, HOSPITALIZATION, SURGERY, MEDICAL PROCEDURES, LABORATORY, X-RAYS, SPECIAL STUDIES AND PHYSICAL THERAPY TREATMENTS.
- D. THE OFFICIAL HOSPITALS ARE:

- STATE URGENT AND EMERGENCY HOSPITAL

13. MEDICAL AND LIFE INSURANCE

- A. EACH COUNTRY, ACCORDING TO WA RULES, IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE INSURANCE OF THE PARTICIPANTS IN ITS DELEGATION. MEMBER FEDERATIONS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR TAKING OUT INSURANCE TO COVER ILLNESS OR INJURY/LIFE FOR THEIR DELEGATION AND/OR TEAM MEMBERS WHEN TRAVELING INTERNATIONALLY.
- B. TEAM LEADERS WILL BE ASKED TO CONFIRM THAT ALL ATHLETES ARE MEDICALLY FIT TO PARTICIPATE AND MUST HAVE A LIST OF RECENT MEDICATIONS/ALLERGIES/ILLNESSES/INJURIES FOR ALL TEAM MEMBERS. MEDICAL FORMS, INCLUDING BLOOD TYPING, MUST BE AVAILABLE TO THE EVENT DOCTOR IN CASE THEY ARE NEEDED IN THE EVENT OF INJURY OR ILLNESS DURING COMPETITION.

14. FACING COVID-19.

A. ONLY PARTICIPANTS AND OTHER PEOPLE WITH A COMPLETE VACCINATION PROTOCOL CAN PARTICIPATE IN THE COMPETITION. PEOPLE WITH A PARTIAL VACCINATION PROTOCOL WILL ONLY BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE EVENT, PROVIDED THEY PRESENT A NEGATIVE RT-PCR RESULT FOR SARS COV-2, CARRIED OUT UP TO 48 HOURS BEFORE THE EVENT, OR AN ANTIGEN TEST CARRIED OUT 24 HOURS BEFORE THE EVENT. ELDERLY PERSONS NOT YET ELIGIBLE FOR VACCINATION MUST HAVE A NEGATIVE RT-PCR RESULT FOR SARS COV-2, PERFORMED WITHIN 48 HOURS PRIOR TO THE EVENT, OR AN ANTIGEN TEST PERFORMED 24 HOURS PRIOR TO THE EVENT.

C. IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT ALL TEAMS VERIFY WITH THE AIRLINES THE REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTERING BRAZIL, BOTH IN RELATION TO DEALING WITH COVID-19, AS WELL AS OTHER REQUIREMENTS.

17. RULES

THE CHAMPIONSHIPS WILL BE HELD IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE WA TECHNICAL REGULATIONS IN FORCE.

18. EVENTS, CATEGORIES AND AGE GROUPS

- A. THE FOLLOWING EVENTS ARE HELD IN THE PAN AMERICAN AND SOUTH AMERICAN CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS, BY CATEGORIES FOR THE ENTRIES OF THE PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES:
- A) 10 KM MEN;
- B) ADULT 10 KM WOMEN;
- C) 8 KM U-20 MEN;
- D) 6 KM U-20 WOMEN;
- B. IN ADDITION, ONLY FOR THE SOUTH AMERICAN CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS ARE THE EVENTS HELD:
- A) 6 KM U-18 MEN;
- B) 4KM U-18 WOMEN.
- C. THE DISTANCES CONTAINED IN THIS ARTICLE CAN BE ADJUSTED DEPENDING ON THE CIRCUIT WHERE THE TESTS ARE CARRIED OUT.
- D. THE AGE GROUPS FOR THE CATEGORIES LISTED IN ARTICLE 4.1 ARE AS FOLLOWS:
- A) U-18: ATHLETES FROM 15 TO 17 YEARS OLD (BORN BETWEEN 2005 AND 2007).
- B) U-20: ATHLETES FROM 16 TO 19 YEARS OLD (BORN FROM 2006 TO 2003).
- C) ADULTS: ATHLETES OVER 18 YEARS OF AGE (BORN AFTER 2004).

26. BIB NUMBERS

THE COMPETITION NUMBERS OF THE ATHLETES WILL BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE TEAM LEADERS AT THE TECHNICAL MEETING. EACH ATHLETE WILL RECEIVE THREE (3) NUMBERS. NUMBERS, FOR THE FRONT AND BACK OF THE COMPETITION SHIRT AND GARMENT BAG, MUST NOT BE FOLDED, AND ATHLETES MUST RESPECT ALL LOGOS OR SCRIPT WRITING.

27.TEAM RANKING

A. TEAM SCORING PAN AMERICAN CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS:

ALL NATIONAL TEAMS WITH A MINIMUM OF FOUR (4) / MAXIMUM SIX (6) ATHLETES WILL COMPETE IN THE PAN AMERICAN CUP. THOSE FEDERATIONS WITH FEWER THAN FOUR RIDERS WILL STILL REMAIN IN THE CALCULATION, BUT CANNOT SCORE AS A TEAM. THE RACE FINISH ORDER IS MAINTAINED AS THE POINTS EARNED BY EACH RIDER, WHETHER PART OF A FULL TEAM OR NOT. SIX (6) ATHLETES FORM A COMPLETE TEAM, WITH THE TOP FOUR (4) ATHLETES PER COUNTRY SCORING. THE TEAM WITH THE LOWEST TOTAL OF FOUR ATHLETES WILL BE DECLARED THE PAN AMERICAN WINNER. IN THE EVENT OF A TIE, IT WILL BE RESOLVED IN FAVOR OF THE TEAM WHOSE 4TH SCORING MEMBER FINISHES CLOSEST TO FIRST PLACE.

B. SCORING OF SOUTH AMERICAN CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS:

THE MINIMUM FOUR (4) / MAXIMUM SIX (6) ATHLETES PER FEDERATION WILL ENTER AND SCORE FOR THE AS CHAMPIONSHIP AGAINST OTHER TEAMS IN THAT AREA ONLY. AREA TEAMS WILL BE SCORED BASED SOLELY ON THE RESULTS OF THE CALCULATED AREA ATHLETES (IE THERE WILL BE NO DISPLACEMENT OF OTHER AREA ATHLETES, SO A NEW SET OF FINISH PLACES PER AREA WILL BE CALCULATED). FOUR (4) ATHLETES PER FEDERATION SCORE, BUT ALL REMAINING TEAM MEMBERS AND INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES FROM COUNTRIES WITHOUT FULL TEAMS REMAIN IN PLACE FOR DISPLACEMENT OF ALL OTHER FINALISTS. THE ORDER OF COMPLETION OF THE RECALCULATED AREA SERVES AS THE POINTS EARNED. THE LOWEST TOTAL OF FOUR (4) FINISHERS PER COUNTRY IS THE AREA CHAMPION FOR EACH OF THE SIX (6) RACING CATEGORIES. IN THE EVENT OF A TIE, IT WILL BE DECIDED IN FAVOR OF THE TEAM WHOSE 4RD SCORING MEMBER FINISHES CLOSEST TO FIRST PLACE.

28. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

ANTI-DOPING TESTS WILL BE CARRIED OUT DURING THE ENTIRE COMPETITION OR OUTSIDE OF IT IN ACCORDANCE WITH WA AND WADA RULES. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL MEASURES WILL BE TAKEN BY THE ABCD (BRAZILIAN DOPING CONTROL AUTHORITY) AND WILL BE SENT TO AN ACCREDITED INTERNATIONAL LABORATORY.

ACCORDING TO WADA RULES, ATHLETES MUST HAVE A LIST OF ALL MEDICATIONS AND SUPPLEMENTS THEY TAKE. FEDERATIONS MUST SUBMIT ALL NECESSARY TUE FORMS TO THE WA OFFICE PRIOR TO THE COMPETITION DATES.



29.PROTESTS

ANY PROTEST OR APPEAL, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE EVENT OFFICIALS, COULD BE SUBMITTED TO THE TIC IN WRITING WITHIN 30 MINUTES OF THE OFFICIAL ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE EVENT RESULTS WITH THE DEPOSIT OF \$100.00 USD IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE WA RULES WHICH WILL BE FORFEITED IF THE APPEAL OR PROTEST IS NOT UPHELD.

THE JURY OF APPEALS WILL DECIDE AFTER CONSIDERING ALL AVAILABLE RESOURCES.

30. MIX ZONE

THE LOCAL ORGANIZING COMMITTEE WILL ACCOMMODATE A MIXED ZONE FOR THE MEDIA TO INTERVIEW THE ATHLETES AFTER THEY FINISH THEIR EVENT. ALL ATHLETES WILL LEAVE THE COMPETITION AREA THROUGH THE MIXED ZONE. THE LOCAL ORGANIZING COMMITTEE WILL GRANT PRESS PASSES FOR THE MIXED ZONE.
